What if I wasn't driving the vehicle at the time of the offence?

Go to www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/fines-and-fees/nominate-someone-else for more information and to login to:

- tell us who was driving the vehicle or
- if the vehicle was sold prior to the date of the offence, who you sold the vehicle to.

Important: If you name another driver, do not send payment as a new fine notice will be issued to them. False nomination is a serious offence and severe penalties apply. If you sell your vehicle notify Transport for NSW or the equivalent authority in your State or Territory.

What if I want to dispute the fine?

You can request a review in certain circumstances or if you believe an error has been made at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/fines-and-fees/request-a-review

What if I want to apply to go to court for the fine?

If you would like to dispute your fine in court, you can find more information and the application form at www.revenue.nsw.gov.au/fines-and-fees/go-to-court. You will need to provide a residential address as we cannot send a court attendance notice to a PO Box.

Note: The court may apply additional costs.
